We will send a full ute load of sheep for this last sale.

Here is a couple we sold at the last auction and those on offer this sale are similar, probably better quality as we dig deeper into our flock to fill the ute.



All ewes are 50% White Dorper/50% Damara. The wether lambs are 75% Damara/25% White Dorper and about 4 weeks old. All ewes have had an embryo lamb and a natural lamb, so are proven breeders in the prime of life. They are good temperament, good shedders – never been shorn. We seldom offer ewes as good as this at auction.

## The Auction will be held at Gatton Saleyards Monday 28th July 2014, 11am sharp.

Sheep are sold first, on the dot of 11am, so do not be late or you will miss the early bargains.
