
Goats and Sheep for Sale at Gatton Auction next Monday, 21st March 2016, 11am

We have decided to sell two more pure bred British Alpine milking goats at auction. There will definitely be no more offered this year – we have just kept our essential milkers and their replacements. These are top class goats only being sold because we have too many.

Goats are often sold first on the dot of 11am so do not be late or you may miss them.

Below are the two goats for sale – a young 2 year old mother who had triplets last year and one of the best of her three doe kids, she is 4 months old:

Our goats are very productive – we get all our own milk, cream, whipped cream, butter, cheese and kefir from them. They are easily trained and lovable. They do not climb fences, and are clean and fastidious in habits. Both healthy, CAE accredited, pure bred British Alpine. Neither goat has ever had any chemical drenches, anti-biotics or wormers, but they do get minerals, sprouted grain, fresh carrots and a varied diet.

We are happy to give advice to people thinking of getting into goat husbandry.
